NOTICE OF REVISED APPLICATION FOR PRELIMINARY PERMIT FOR POWER PROJECT

Notice hereby is given that The California Oregon Power Company, whose address is Medford, Oregon, has filed with the Hydroelectric Commission of Oregon a revised application for a preliminary permit to appropriate water for the development of a water power project (designated on the records of the Commission as Project No. 23) for the generation of 56,000 theoretical horsepower, more or less, said water to be appropriated from the water of the State of Oregon in a stream known as the North Umpqua River, a tributary of Umpqua River. It is proposed to divert 1200 cubic feet per second, more or less, of such water at a point 12,790 feet South and 30,760 feet East from the corner of Sections 14, 23 and 24, Township 26 South, Range 2 East, W. M., in Douglas County, to a power plant 7600 feet Northwesterly from said point of diversion.

Said application is made subject to the terms of Title 119, Chapter 1, Oregon Compiled Laws Annotated, and is subject to protests or remonstrances on behalf of the public, or any district organized for public purposes, or any interested private person or persons, on the grounds set forth in said Title 119, Chapter 1.

All protests and remonstrances shall be in writing, in duplicate, shall state the grounds thereof, and shall be filed with the Commission at Salem, Oregon, on or before March 15, 1945.
