Farm Copper Wire

Quotas Slightly Down

The War Production board's recent suspension of copper wire deliveries to retailers does not affect farmers' copper wire certificates issued by count AAA committees. These certificates represent allotments of copper wire under the controlled material plan, and retailers may extend them to distributors and manufacturers to obtain wire.

Farm copper wire quotas for the current quarter, however, are somewhat less than quotas for previous quarters. Farm requests are considerably in excess of quotas, and it is probably that many applications cannot be acted upon until after March 31, when the next quarterly quota is due.
