MEAT, BUTTER, CHEESE—Book 4: Red stamps G3 through 55 valid through March 31. Red stamps T3 through 23 valid through April 21. Red stamps 33 through 12 valid through June 2. Red stamps E2 through 12 valid through June 30.

SUGAR—Book 4: Sugar stamp 35 valid through June 2. SUGAR—Loose stamps invalid. Book 2: Airplane stamps 1-3-3 now valid.
