Predecessor Of Hitler Sparing Of Views in U. S.

Cambridge, Mass.—If the quiz question was who was Hitler's predecessor as chancellor of Germany and what is he doing now, many could answer "Dr. Heinrich Brüning, now professor of government at Harvard University."

Only a few, however, could tell much more about him or the kind of life he leads now.

Dr. Brüning, a German machine gun officer in World War I, who held the chancellorship from March 29, 1930, to May 30, 1932, leads a studious, almost monastic life these days. He has a few intimate friends.

He never speaks "for the record," and interviews are taboo. Even conjecture that he might be called to fill a place in any reorganization of Germany draws no response from him.

He Opposed Hitler
Brüning, who was one of the few who dared stand up against Hitler during his rise to power, apparently is following his "work and pray" motto, which he laid down for himself even before he became a figure in German politics.

His associates mostly are other professors in the various departments at Harvard. But no one knows if he opens his heart to them, for they keep his even least confidential utterances as they might a military secret. His students classify him as "an able, witty instructor."

He lectures outside the university infrequently, even less than when he first arrived, and is cautious to make no statements that might be construed as commitments.
