CAUSE FOR ALARM

We dislike the role of alarmist but we feel the public should take cognizance of a very serious condition existing in the fringe area of Roseburg, where lack of sanitary facilities could result in a most serious health menace.

The city of Roseburg, within its municipal boundaries, is provided with adequate sewers and has one of the finest disposal plants of its size on the Pacific coast.

West Roseburg, Edenbow, Riverside, Miller's Addition, Deer Creek and other suburban areas have experienced very rapid growth. These districts have no sewers.

We have been urging the people of the residential areas immediately adjacent to the city to form fire protection districts. It is reported that steps to organize against the fire danger already have been taken.

In addition to fire protection districts, we also urge the formation of sanitary districts. The state law provides procedure whereby districts may be created, officers named and sewers installed at the expense of property owners.

But before the city can utilize its disposal plant to care for outside areas, it must spend a considerable sum of money to separate storm water from the sanitary sewer system.

We have heard some property owners adjacent to the city, concerned by existing conditions, urge annexation to Roseburg. But, insofar as expense of sewer installation is concerned, annexation would prove of no benefit.

We believe organization of sanitary and fire protection districts are of immediate necessity in Roseburg's entire fringe area for the safety of life and property.

There is, however, one action possible to head off an epidemic and that is through immunization. Typhoid "shots" have been proven to protect against this dread disease.

Captured Nazi Rifles Gifts to V. V. Harpham

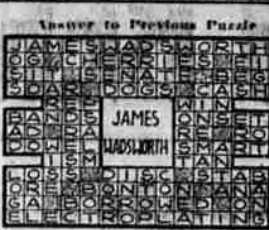
