Roseburg Local Backs Miners in Pay Hike Demand

Roseburg local, No. 307, International Woodworkers of America (CIO) has endorsed the program of the United Mine Workers to secure improved wages and working conditions, Fred W. Taylor, business agent, reported today. The local has expressed its stand in the following resolution, passed at a recent meeting:

WHEREAS: The United Mine Workers are now in the midst of negotiations with their employers on demands covering the improvement of their hours, wages and working conditions; and—

WHEREAS: Gains made by any large segment of the working class strengthens the position of all workers in their attempt to gain their rightful share of what they produce; and—

WHEREAS: The solidarity of all producers should be evinced in a united stand for an improvement of these conditions common to all, even as their unity in the past is exemplified by the slogan "An injury to one is an injury to all."

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That Local 307, International Woodworkers of America, Roseburg, Oregon, go on record as being in full accord with and solidly behind the United Mine Workers in their demands upon the mine owners.

FURTHER RESOLVED: That a copy of this resolution be sent to the International Woodworker, the Columbia River District council, the United Mine Workers and to the public press.

D. A. Thornburg, Veteran Of World War I, Passes

Dennis A. Thornburg, 77, veteran of World War I, and resident of Forest Grove, Oregon, died at the Veterans hospital Saturday. He was born in Iowa February 9, 1868, and served as a first lieutenant in the U. S. infantry during the last war.
