Disbursement of Welfare Funds in Douglas Shown

The sum of \$52,383.12 is the annual payroll for Douglas county by the Bureau of Old Age Insurance of the Social Security board. These figures were released today by Charles H. Cannon, manager for the board, in Eugene, in commenting on the figures. Cannon gave the following breakdown: 117 men past 65 years of age received \$31,770.96 a year; 34 wives who were past 65 received \$4,273.32 a year; 78 children of deceased workers received \$10,317.80 a year; 13 widows of deceased workers, with minor children in their care, received \$3,675.48 a year; 11 aged widows—that is, widows past 65—of deceased workers, received \$3,675.48 a year.

Since January 1, 1945, \$37.00 has been paid out in Douglas county in the form of lump sum claims where no monthly benefits were payable.

"A large number of retired workers are moving to Oregon," Cannon states. "These people are buying small acreages, and plan to spend the remaining years of their lives here. Most of them have other savings and income in addition to the purchase price of their new homes. Here is Social Security in operation. It can be safely estimated that in addition to the annual payroll of \$52,383.12, these people will spend an additional \$75,000.00 a year in Douglas county. This means \$127,383.12 of new money for Douglas county, each year."
