Civilian Supplies of Butter, Cheese Unchanged

WASHINGTON, May 18—(AP)—The civilian supplies of butter during June and July will continue at the present monthly rate of about 50,000,000 pounds, the War Food administration announced today.

Likewise, civilian supplies of cheese during June will be at about the same level as in recent months—36,000,000 pounds.

WFA said that manufacturers will be required to set aside 55 per cent of their June and 50 per cent of their July output of butter for war needs. The government will take 70 per cent of the June cheddar cheese production compared with 65 per cent this month.

The government is following a policy of obtaining the bulk of its yearly military and lend-lease requirements of dairy products during the spring and summer months of heavy milk production.
