Reduced Bond Liberates Woman in Homicide Case

BRIDGEPORT, Conn., July 13—(AP)—Mrs. Imogene Stevens, 24, wife of Paratrooper Major G. Ralsey Stevens, 30, posted a bond of \$15,000 yesterday and was liberated from jail, where she has been held since June 24 on a charge of manslaughter in the shooting of a young submarine sailor at New Canaan.

Bond originally was set at \$50,000 in the New Canaan town court where the self-admitted slayer of Albert Kovacs of Norwalk was bound over to the superior court on a charge of manslaughter.

Mrs. Stevens has been adjudged criminally responsible for the death of the 19-year-old submarine veteran.

The girl's looking mother of a six-year-old daughter by a previous marriage left the court house with the major who was home on 30 days leave. Both seemed happy but had nothing to say.

Fall Into Gorge Fatal

BEND, Ore., July 13—(AP)—Injuries suffered when he plummeted into the Crooked river gorge after slipping on scaffolding were fatal yesterday to Harold Meeker, 53.

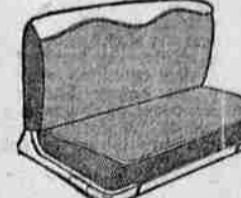
