## Spread Between Feeder, Slaughter Stock Narrows

The spread between prices of feeder cattle and slaughter cattle in early September, including the 50-cent subsidy paid to producers for slaughter cattle weighing over 800 pounds, was slightly narrower than a year earlier. The Department of Agriculture expects the prices of feeder cattle to decline further in the next two months since they will not find such a ready outlet in the slaughter markets as existed during the past two years when military procurement of canned meat was larger. On the other hand, the USDA expects prices of fed cattle will be well maintained at near present levels into early 1946, with a continued strong demand for well-finished cattle and a seasonal reduction in marketings of such cattle.
