Zhuikov Sees Short Reich Occupation If Germans Help

BERLIN, Nov. 13.—(AP)—An American staff sergeant who "crashed" Marshal Zhukov's reception Wednesday night quoted the Russian military leader today as saying the allied occupation of Germany "could be completed in less than 10 years if the Germans are cooperative."

The sergeant, Harold Kempner of Philadelphia, is a reporter for "Gruoper," the weekly newspaper of the American Military government. Kempner had no invitation to Zhukov's party, at which Gen. Eisenhower was the ranking guest, but after he got in he went straight to the point. "Our job in Germany could be completed in less than 10 years if the Germans are cooperative and display an earnest desire to rid themselves of any taint of militarism and Nazi ideology," Kempner, who was born in Russia and lived in Lithuania, asked the marshal in fluent Russian when he would visit the United States. He quoted Zhukov as replying: "I am anxious to visit your land but important work will keep me busy here for a while. I hope, however, to be in the United States early next spring."

7 Killed, 61 Wounded in Bucharest Demonstration

BUCHAREST, Nov. 13.—(AP)—A check of hospitals and mortuaries today showed that at least seven persons were killed and 61 wounded in a six-hour riot between Romanian soldiers and demonstrators celebrating King Mihai's 24th birthday, which was finally halted last week by a Russian general. The rioting developed in Bucharest's Royal square as a crowd assembled in defiance of an order by Premier Groza banning public celebration of the king's birthday. (The interior ministry was quoted in a Bucharest radio broadcast as saying that recent disorders were "anarchist activities" planned under the cloak of a monarchist demonstration. The Groza government has been at the odds with the king since it refused his request that it resign and he, in turn, has refused to sign the papers which would legalize its decisions.)

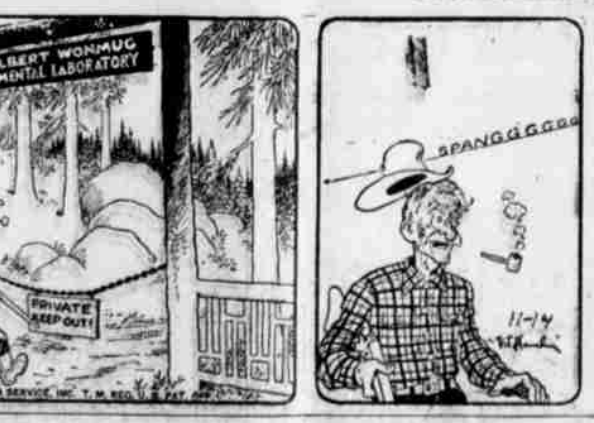
