Price Ceilings on Frozen and Drawn Poultry Revised

WASHINGTON, Nov. 14.—(AP)—The OPA announced revised price ceilings for certain kinds of cleaned and drawn frozen poultry.

Effective Saturday, these increases apply to retail and at all other sales levels:

Cleaned and drawn frozen broilers, 13¢ a pound; light fowl, 24¢ a pound; heavy fowl, 1 cent a pound. The ceiling for poultry fat also is being increased one cent a pound.

OPA said the higher prices will enable the industry to resume production of these items.

At the same time the agency ordered a cut of two cents a pound in ceilings for cleaned and drawn frozen geese. This reduction is designed to restore a normal price differential, OPA said.

The agency exempted from price control sales or deliveries of live poultry by members of 4-H clubs, Future Farmers of America, or other recognized youth organizations. The exemption applies when sales or deliveries are made at the place and time of a fair, and have been approved in advance by an OPA district office.
