notions like that in your creditor's mind is never good business.

OUR best-informed people DOUBT that Britain is going off the deep end into the social pool. They think the British people will be likely to stop with merely dabbling their toes in the water—that all they really want is a little LESS TORYISM and quite a little more personal opportunity for ALL KINDS of Britons.

Attlee seems to be trying to prepare us for the idea that they're going in all over. Naturally, coming from the head of the British government, that upsets us.

THE censorship clouds lift enough to permit us to see the makings of a SHOWDOWN in China.

THOUSANDS of American-trained and American-equipped Chinese Nationalist (Chungking) troops are landing from U. S. transports at Taingtuo, which is and has been for weeks RINGED AROUND by Chinese Communist troops.

It looks as if we may be saying to the Chinese Reds: "This is IT. What are you going to do about it?"

RUSSIA is the key to this Chinese civil war business. IF we're giving the dare to the Communists in China, two possibilities are suggested:

1. We have an understanding with Russia.

2. We're calling RUSSIA'S bluff.

(KEEP in mind that this is all pure guesswork. With the facts obscured by censorship, guessing is all we can do.)

SECRETARY of State Byrnes "discloses" that the U. S. and Russia are deadlocked over Soviet demands for an allied control council for Japan. (The Russians want a council in which they will hold VETO power. We want a council in which MacArthur will DECIDE in case of a disagreement, thus giving us control.)

Byrnes said several weeks ago that the American idea was ACCEPTABLE to Russia. He now reveals that there has been a shift in the Russian position.

INCIDENTALLY, there is a suggestion in a MOSCOW dispatch that the Russians may be on the track of SPLITTING LEAD ATOMS. The point is that lead is PLENTIFUL, whereas uranium is extremely scarce.

Over ALL international relations hangs the shadow of the atom bomb.

THERE is still bitter fighting in Soerabaya (Java).

The British accuse the commander of the Jap 16th Army (after the Jap surrender) of having deliberately handed over arms and supplies to UNRULY elements in Java this idea, presumably, being to stir up all the trouble he could.

The picture of what is going on in Java is still far from clear.

A HUNGRY Japan appeals officially to us for food and fuel—and promises to PAY, in installments, by shipments of gold, diamonds, silk and other goods. Jap Minister of Commerce Ogawara, in apply formally for imports (which will come principally from America) says that Japan's alternatives are simple:

REPRESENTATIVE J. W. MOTT

Oregon's capital city is in mourning today as the state pays final tribute to James W. Mott, representative in Congress from the First district since 1933. Funeral services at the House of Representatives this afternoon are the closing chapter in a political career which embraced the Oregon State legislature, the office of state corporation commissioner, and 13 years in the Congress, in addition to many appointments to positions of respect and honor.

Until the election of 1942, Douglas county was a part of Representative Mott's district. In fact, it was a matter of vital concern to Douglas county that launched Mr. Mott upon his career as congressman.

The late W. C. Hawley was serving as representative in Congress and had pledged his support to Roseburg's application for site of the Northwest Soldiers Home, an institution which since has become known as the Roseburg Veterans Facility. In spite of great pressure brought to bear by political influences in Lane and other counties, trying to wrest the site from Roseburg, Congressman Hawley remained firm to his promise. He had formed other political enemies during his 26-year tenure of office and the rift over the veterans facility afforded an opportunity for Mott to win the 1932 election by a very close vote.

That Douglas county's almost unanimous vote for Congressman Hawley in that election was not directed personally against Mott, was evidenced in succeeding elections, when he was given substantial majorities.

"Jim" Mott was well known and liked in Douglas county, which remained a part of his congressional district until 1942, when the Fourth district was formed.

Representative Mott's work in Congress has been of outstanding character. He has consistently worked for the interests of his state and district, particularly in advocating federal support for highways, river and harbor improvements, industrial development, and many other projects of great importance. He was particularly vigorous in demanding and securing installation of the naval base at the mouth of the Columbia river, and in assisting Klamath Falls in obtaining its naval air training station, Marine barracks, and other facilities.

Following the death of the late Senator Charles L. McNary, he became the senior member of the Oregon delegation. He held high-ranking committee appointments, through seniority and ability, and discharged his responsibilities with credit to himself and his state.

Douglas county will have no part in the selection of his successor, but will follow with interest the choice of a man to succeed to the office Mr. Mott filled so ably during the past 13 years.

The position of representative in Congress is distinctive in the fact that he MUST be chosen by the people. The governor may appoint a senator to fill a vacancy, but a representative can be named only by the people of the district he serves. Thus it will be necessary that a special election be called in the rear future to name Mott's successor. Otherwise the office would remain vacant until the next regular election.

Candidates may be nominated by petition or by party caucus.

Following the final rites in Salem today, it may be safely assumed that the political pot will be brought to a boil quickly in the state's First Congressional district.

Lieut. Ivan Brown Observes Ruins of Japanese Cities

Lt. Ivan Brown, son of Mrs. Sadie Cannon, Roseburg, recently had opportunity for first-hand observation of the effect of B-29 bombing of Japanese cities.

A B-29 navigator, Lt. Brown went overseas last August, but arrived too late to participate in air raids on the Japanese homeland. Stationed in the Shima, he recently flew with a C-47 to Tokyo, Osaka, and other Japanese cities.

On one leg of their flight they were forced down by bad weather short of their destination. It was the first American plane to land in that area and the fliers were somewhat doubtful of the nature of their reception. They had their weapons ready for defense.

They were met, however, by a Japanese naval officer driving a long, sleek automobile. Loaded into the car they were driven through the main part of the city, while the driver kept his horn going constantly. Japanese people thronged to the street and bowed low as the Americans were driven by.

The fliers were welcomed to the naval headquarters and were then escorted to the town's best hotel, where the best accommodations were provided for them.

It is impossible to describe the destruction wrought on Japanese cities by American bombs, Lt. Brown writes. He told of seeing whole blocks of cities reduced to rubble as a result of explosives dropped from American planes.

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One Defendant in Attack Case Freed, Second on Trial

Dewey Washington, Siletz Indian, indicted by the grand jury on a charge of armed assault and robbery, was free today after a circuit court jury returned a verdict of not guilty late Thursday following a two-day trial.

The court was engaged today in the trial of Ben Thomas Childers, who was indicted jointly with Washington.

Childers and Washington, known as Redport and "Big Indian" and "Little Indian," were alleged to have beaten Joseph Oscar Plumber last August 2, at his trailer house in Reedsport, and to have taken from him the sum of \$175. The assault charged by the state and denied by the defendants is claimed by the state to have followed the drinking by the three men of a quart bottle of rum.

Plumber claimed the two Indians went to his trailer house to negotiate the sale of a clock, and that they attacked him with a shoe and section of gas pipe, slugging him into unconsciousness and taking his money.

Safekeeping Gift Alleged Washington, who was freed by the jury, claimed in his own defense that Plumber, in an intoxicated condition, gave him the money which was found in his possession to keep for him and to return later, and that he left Plumber and Childers together in the trailer house, Childers being asleep at the time Washington departed. Washington claimed he was at the home of friends at the time the attack was alleged to have occurred.

Two Drain Girls Missing; Aid Asked In Locating Them

EUGENE, Ore., Nov. 17.—Parents of both Wanda Mavis Lynette Foster, 14, and Norma Hickethier, 17, of Drain, who have been missing from their homes since Tuesday morning, joined Thursday in a request for aid in locating the two girls.

Believed to have been angered by refusal of permission to attend a football game in Roseburg, the two girls left Drain Tuesday morning, ostensibly to go to a doctor's office in Springfield, and have not returned home. They did not visit the doctor.

Their parents, Mr. and Mrs. Oleville Foster and Mr. and Mrs. Rufus Hickethier, have notified state police, Eugene police, the U. S. marshal's office in Springfield, and the bureau of missing persons in Portland.

Both girls have dark blond hair and blue eyes. Wanda Foster is 5 feet 2 inches tall and weighs 127 pounds. She has two distinct dimples when smiling. She was wearing a blue shirt, blue denim overalls, mannish-style gray coat, brown-and-white saddle oxfords. She may use any of her names—Wanda, Mavis or Lynette—her parents said.

Norma Hickethier is about 5 feet 4 inches tall and weighs about 130 pounds. She wears brown slacks, brown-and-yellow check jacket, brown-and-white saddle oxfords.

Both girls had worked as waitresses and may resume such work, it was said.

Anyone having information regarding them is asked to notify the authorities mentioned, or the parents at Drain.
