Dr. Klaus Karl Schillner, 74, who killed many prisoners in experiments through which he sought a malaria vaccine, and S.S. Officer Martin Weiss, commander of the camp, were among the 36 sentenced to die. Schillner, who last week begged the court for time to complete his experimental records, blinked his eyes rapidly and bowed his bearded head when he heard the words: "Death by hanging."
