good apostle for American foreign policy. If our diplomats can follow the broad trail he has blazed throughout the world, American leadership will be effective.

THE Christmas Eve news this year had its SIGNIFICANT as well as its pitiful points.

In Paris, children whose parents still can't buy new shoes for them "pressed their noses against show windows displaying toy jeeps costing \$175 each and TOO-EXPENSIVE dolls."

Stores in Rome, blacked out by a power shortage, "displayed an abundance of cheeses, nuts and confections at which the worker making \$2 a day could only LOOK."

SUCH are the fruits of inflation, which makes black markets rich and STARVES decent, ordinary people.

The lesson we must learn is that inflation arises out of LACK OF PRODUCTION.

IN contrast with most of the world, this Christmas season in America is a riotous time. ALL-TIME sales records have been falling like a row of dominoes when the end one is pushed over.

It is FINE, of course. In its way, it dramatizes the blessed fact that the American way of life is BETTER because it brings the American people more of the good things of life. The war has PROVED that fact to the satisfaction of every intelligent thinker.

BUT we mustn't let ourselves forget that America can't REMAIN an island of riotous prosperity in a bankrupt world. EVENTUALLY, we must either bring the rest of the world UP or we will be DRAGGED DOWN. That is one of these hard truths that can't be escaped.

THERE is an undertone of gravity in the fantastic song of this GAY Christmas season in America.

MONEY is plentiful. THINGS are scarce.

More money is being spent, but LESS THINGS are being obtained for it. To the observing eye and the understanding brain, that spells danger.

That is how starvation started throughout this hungry world.

HUNDREDS of thousands of Americans who have seen people starving with their pockets stuffed with money are hoping fervently that after this splurging Christmas season we all get back to work MAKING THINGS. ONLY more things can restore PLENTY.

JUST one more thought for this Christmas season:

The world is theoretically at peace again. But it is an uneasy peace in an uneasy world. Thoughtful people are coming slowly to realize that there can be no lasting peace until there is wider acceptance of the teachings of Jesus, whose birthday is celebrated on Christmas.

WHY DEFLATE IT?

"Some of our western towns never seem to grow up. They want to pose as relics of the Old West, of the gun-toting, rip-roaring, hell-for-leather west, most of which never was."

No one can question the truth of Editor Sprague's statement, but why deflate our legends and traditions?

Legend always exaggerates, and the wild west which survives in western movies and western adventure stories is the magnified glorification of a west which was by no means universal.

Editor Sprague's comment was prompted by a report from a Klamath county grand jury which, while investigating complaints of widespread gambling, said:

It recommends to the law enforcement bodies a policy in this respect which takes into consideration the character and needs of Klamath county, including its topography, industry and inhabitants.

In other words, the grand jury recognized that people in Klamath county revel in historic legend which painted a picture of a bad, bold community; a community where men took their liquor straight, their poker seriously, and kept their Colts in readiness to enforce their own laws or lack thereof.

Thus it is officially proclaimed that the people of Klamath county are "DIFFERENT" from the ordinary run, for whom gambling laws were made.

This idea of being "different" is paying big dividends in a good many spots.

Talk to a Californian about California weather and you'll find that any disturbance is "unusual". California's normal weather is "a little better than perfect."

Talk to a Texan and you'll learn that Texas is a part of the United States only because its people feel sorry for the Union and want to help it along. Any Texan will tell you that we would have lost the late war had it not been for Texas' contribution. And he'll even prove it to you if you'll give him time.

The Californian or the Texan isn't fooling himself or anyone else by his pose, but both he and his listener enjoy the make-believe, the provincial pride, the ego-satisfying pretension of being "different."

For many years there has been a determined trend toward uniformity. Our educational system has endeavored to "standardize" education to the point where individual characteristics and personality were subjugated to a common mold. Every city has tried to make itself like every other city. Individuality has been stifled. Homogeneity has been overemphasized.

Though it may be a juvenile characteristic to seek to be "different", we get a kick out of it. Maybe it's because we're juvenile minded. But if so there's a lot of others like us. This desire to be "different" can be made to pay dividends when applied commercially. It appeals to our ego. Much of our affectation is founded upon wild west legend. Why deflate it?
