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Indicted Culvert Firms

Change Their Pleas

SEATTLE, Dec. 28.—Five of the Pacific Coast culvert manufacturers, indicted some months ago on anti-trust law violation charges, today withdrew their pleas of innocence and substituted pleas of "no contest." Judge Lloyd L. Black said he would on January 7 fix the dates for handing down sentences. The sixth firm will appear later.

Those changing pleas today included the Oregon Culvert & Pipe Co., Portland, and E. W. Gibson, vice-president, and Matthew Pottier, secretary; Beall Pipe & Tank Co., Portland, and Frank W. Roring, manager; the California Corrugated Culvert Co., Berkeley, Calif., and H. W. Force, president, and C. R. Hodgson, general manager; The Hydraulic Supply Manufacturing Co., Seattle, and the Washington Culvert & Pipe Co., Seattle, and its manager, Marvin R. Ambuhl.

Husband Murders Wife, Attempts to Kill Self

SEATTLE, Dec. 27.—(AP)—Ella Mae Manley, 36, was dead and her husband, George Dewey Manley, 48, was seriously wounded today in what sheriff's officers said was a murder and attempted suicide, yesterday.

Capt. Lyle Lathrop of the sheriff's staff said Manley told officers he had shot his wife and then turned the gun on himself.

Lathrop said this note was found scrawled on the back of Manley's car:

"Alcohol is poison. She is at peace now. Read your Bible."

He said it had no apparent connection with the unexplained shooting.
