Stiff Censorship Hits Catholics in Poland

CHICAGO, Jan. 8.—(AP)—The Rev. Aloystis Wycisklo, a Catholic priest recently returned from Poland, declared yesterday the name of the Pope can not be mentioned in the Catholic pulp or press of Poland as the result of a censorship imposed by the present Polish government.

Father Wycisklo said in an interview that Polish Catholic priests and bishops had told him "they could not say what they pleased in church and that they were not allowed to mention the name of the Holy Father in pieces or pulp."
