Three Truckloads Of Old Clothes So Far Picked Up

Three truckloads of old clothes have been picked up from collecting stations in the Victory Clothing Drive, Chairman William D. Green, Jr., announced yesterday. He said that the local goal, set at 10,000 garments, has now been reduced by 1,000 as the result of contributions to the clothing collection since the drive began. Plans are under way for a door-to-door collection of old clothes from Roseburg citizens, who have been unable to bring their donations to the collection boxes set up by merchants, banks, theaters, schools, and churches.

Green suggested that contributions to the Victory Clothing Drive should be enclosed in cartons and tied for shipment, with the contents of the box itemized on the outside.

It is not necessary this year to mend clothing or to sort it out according to type or size, as this is done before shipment overseas. Merchants are requested to retain all cartons in which they receive goods. The cartons can be given to anyone wishing to contribute clothing, shoes, bedding, or other such items. In selecting cartons, contributors should pick ones that will hold their gifts without leaving much empty space, which otherwise the local committee would have to fill before shipment, Green stated.
