

Device to Harvest Shell Peas at One Operation Sought

WASHINGTON, Feb. 13.—(AP)—The Agriculture Department should design a machine to harvest and shell peas in one operation, Rep. Stockman (R-Ore.) told the House Appropriations Committee today.

Stockman said such a machine would be of great value in Oregon and Washington. They rank fourth and third, respectively, as producers of canneries peas.

The fertilizer and fodder value of the vines is lost in the present method of harvest. Pea vines now are cut and carried from the field to a machine which shells and cleans them. The vines are piled up and decay because the cost of returning them to the fields is high, Stockman said.

"Oregon growers," he told the committee, "are convinced that is needed is a combined harvester-sheller which will cut the vines and shell the peas in one operation. This will leave the vines and broken pods on the field where they can be cured for forage or left in place for soil improvement."

He said the problem of designing and testing such a machine is beyond the capabilities of pea growers and that manufacturers of farm machinery did not seem interested.

"The division of mechanical processing of the Bureau of Plant Industry has a well equipped shop and laboratory at Corvallis, Ore., where if additional funds were made available, it could undertake the development of this equipment," Stockman said.

He urged the committee to provide an adequate appropriation for research in development of the proposed equipment.
