Oyster Festival Dated At Bay City June 15-16

BAY CITY, Ore., June 2.—The Bay City Oyster Festival, the last of which was held in 1941, and was one of the outstanding events of the Oregon Coast, is being rejuvenated by the Bay City Chamber of Commerce. It will be held this year on the 15 and 16 of June, and by the out of state inquiries and the elaborate plans being made, it promises to be one of the biggest and best festivals yet staged.

It is estimated that there will be at least 20,000 people attending and there will be oysters for all, and all for free, with generous prizes offered for all contests.

Butter Shortage At All-Time Low In Distribution

SEATTLE, June 2.—(AP)—Commenting on the current butter shortage, the federal-state agriculture departments' market news service said Saturday that "distribution is at an all-time historical low, on delayed rail receipts and the withdrawal of supplies from the market by many dealers pending a price rise of about 11 cents."

It added that many cheese dealers and shippers similarly have been withholding offerings pending official confirmation of about a 6 cent advance, and dealers were withholding evaporated milk pending the expected 35 cents a case price increase.

It said the milk flow gained sharply the past week and the peak of flush production was near at hand.

"Heavy demands readily absorbed increased supplies" the summary added. "The office of economic stabilization authorized

price advances on fluid milk, butter, cheese and evaporated milk, and moved to control butterfat usage by cream ceilings and reduction of butterfat content of ice cream. Whipping cream is to be banned July 1.

"Most orders will be effective June 1 or as soon thereafter as possible."

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
