

Plans Announced For Convention of VFW at Corvallis

CORVALLIS, Ore., June 4.—Oregon's first postwar veterans' convention, the 1946 Silver Jubilee and Victory Encampment of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, will open with a distinctly cosmopolitan flavor at Corvallis the end of this month as delegates and visitors numbering nearly 10,000 partake of Russian foods atop majestic, snow-capped Mary's Peak, high in the Coast Range and overlooking the convention city and the entire Willamette valley.

Dr. Harry J. Anderson, chairman of the barbecue, has promised one of the outstanding events of the year, and in cooperation with the entire Russian colony south of Corvallis and headed by Wm. Dobrinin, will barbecue nearly fifty head of cattle to feed the veterans and their honored guests.

Governor Snell will be a featured speaker at the barbecue and other sessions of the convention. Past National Commander James E. Van Zandt, Mayor Earl Riley of Portland and other national, state and city officials will be on hand for the encampment, according to Stanley Trip, general chairman of the convention.

Ample Housing Assured
To assure adequate housing for the veterans and their wives, Ed Allworth is heading a committee working out details that will make a number of college fraternities and sororities available during the encampment. Additional rooms are being secured by the Corvallis Chamber of Commerce in private homes. Hotels and tourist camps report an almost complete sell-out of reservations and visitors who have not already made provisions are requested to do so at once.

A joint memorial service for the honored dead of all wars will be held at the Methodist church on Sunday evening, June 30, while business sessions are scheduled to get under way early on Monday, July 1.

The big military, civil and fraternal parade will be held on the evening of July 1. Spotlights of the convention will center on the banquet and ball to be held at the Elks temple on the evening of July 2. Election of officers and presentation of department awards and prizes will feature the business sessions on the closing day, July 3.

Top British Battlers
Will Seek Bouts in U. S.

LONDON, June 5.—(AP)—Bruce Woodcock, British heavyweight boxing champion, and Freddie Mills, who he outpointed last night in a 12-round "consolation" fight three weeks after their knockouts by Americans, both looked to the United States today for future hopes of fistic fame.

Mills, the British light heavyweight titleholder, and his manager, Ted Broadbribb, will leave for New York Sunday.

"We are going to see the Louisville bout and all other good American fighters we can," said Broadbribb, who took Tommy Farr to the United States in 1937.

Woodcock, who in beating Mills subdued the best opposition available in Britain, has no immediate plans for returning to the United States but his manager, Tom Hurst, said he had "some good offers from America."

Plans for entertaining a "round of Princes of Syracuse" who will be in Roseburg over the weekend, were made at a meeting of Alpha Lodge, No. 47, Knights of Pythias, Chancellor Commander E. G. High announced. It is hoped that the visit of these boys and young men, who are coming here from Yakima on a good-will tour, will result in the forming of a local chapter of the order.

Membership in this order is limited to boys between the ages of 12 and 16, and those interested in becoming members of a Roseburg chapter are urged to contact Mr. High at 101 S. Jackson St., between now and Saturday, June 8.

The Yakima boys are scheduled to arrive in Roseburg at 6:30 P. M. Saturday. They will be entertained by local members of the Knights of Pythias and by local boys who are interested in the Princes of Syracuse. If they show sufficient interest a charter will be formed here, High said.

At the regular meeting of Alpha Lodge Monday night, Arthur C. Evans of Rt. 2, Roseburg, was initiated into the rank of nape. At next Monday's meeting, the rank of esquire will be conferred.
