

Affidavits Accuse Head of Jap Camp

YOKOHAMA, June 13.—(AP)—Introduction of affidavits in the war crimes trial of Lt. Takekazu Hirata, commander of Fukuoka prisoner of war camp 23, started today before an Eighth Army commission.

Hirata is charged with permitting subordinates to commit atrocities.

Earl J. Wilson, RFD 5, Olympia, Wash., in an affidavit said that for failing to report to a mine officer when he went to work he was struck by the mine foreman on his legs, arms and head with a hammer swung from a three-foot handle.

Statements from Alfred P. Kline, Seattle, declared he was beaten for going on sick call, and Pvt. Erwin J. Kilburn, Lake Placid, N. Y., testified he was refused medical aid and was frequently beaten after standing at attention for six hours because he had failed to report for sick call on the previous day.

The trial of Yoshio Kameoka, former employee at a Nagoya camp was due to open June 15 on charges of contributing to the death of Av. Ord. Doyle W. Waggoner, Shreveport, La. Kameoka is also accused of beating six other Americans including E. J. White, Olympia, Wash.
