War-Type Devices on Display at Lund's Shop

Equipment representing more than \$5,000, much of it the same type used in World War II battles and in the recent contact with the moon by the U. S. Army Signal Corps, is on display at Lund's Radio Shop in Roseburg this week.

Purchased from government surplus supplies, Lund will use parts from this once-expensive equipment in his 1000-watt amateur station at his home. All equipment is practically new and unused and one of the tubes in the largest set is worth \$65 alone, Lund reports. Other mechanisms are almost priceless at present to radio hobbyists.

As well as a set of Handy-Talkies, a two-way portable sending and receiving set used throughout the war by combat troops, Lund has on display in his windows a complete tank unit, transmitter and receiver combined, which is the same type used in the Sherman tank by the British and Russian armies; and a complete 100,000 watt radar unit, the same as used by the U. S. Army Signal Corps in "shooting" the moon. This equipment, used by the Army on mobile units, includes a main feeder transmitter, receiver, and a frequency meter for checking on proper wave lengths.

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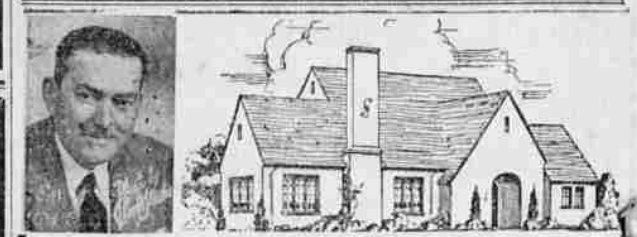

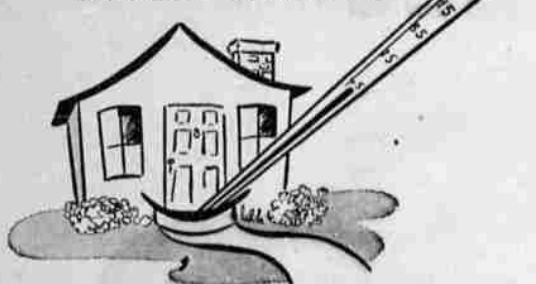

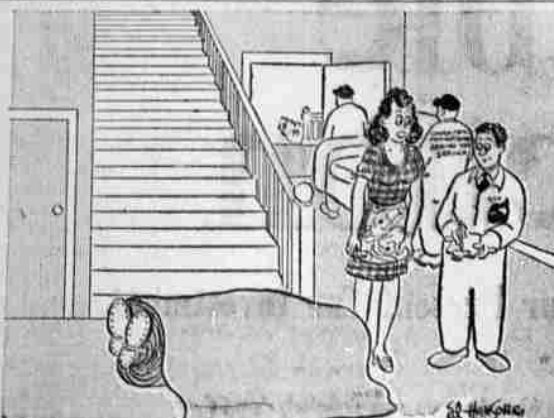
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
