

## New Edition of Oregon Driver's Manual Issued

An entirely new edition of the Oregon Driver's Manual has just been released by Secretary of State Farrell.

In more fully illustrated format, the manual is intended primarily to give new drivers the rules of the road. Like earlier editions, it will be issued to all those who desire to be examined for driver's licenses in Oregon. Farrell is urging all highway users to study it, however.

"It is hoped that the material will serve a far broader purpose by encouraging among drivers and pedestrians alike a desire and an ability to assist in the promotion of greater safety for all on the streets and highways of Oregon," Farrell said.

Designed not to be memorized but to be understood, the manual is far more readable than any previous edition. It features large type, prominent headings, and actual photographs in place of most sketches. Highway signs are illustrated in color. The material is presented in extremely brief sections and everyday language.

Included for the first time is a check-list of driving faults similar to the one used by examiners giving driver's license tests.

Another feature is a sample test on Oregon traffic laws. Anyone who studies the manual thoroughly should be able to pass with a perfect or near-perfect grade.

Farrell emphasized that it is not an actual copy of the law. "Technical explanations and exact wordings have been omitted intentionally for the purpose of making the subject matter readily understandable," Farrell said.

Improvements will be made wherever tests show that part of the manual is not understood. The secretary of state is soliciting comments and suggestions from all who study it. The manual may be obtained free of cost from all enforcement authorities and drivers license examiners or by writing to Robert S. Farrell, Jr., Secretary of State, Salem.
