Negro Eludes Posse to Surrender; Others Sought

MAGEE, Miss., Aug. 20.—(AP)—Johnny Craft, one of three Negro brothers hunted by a posse in connection with the ambush shooting of four white men, sur-

rendered at Jackson today and the search for the other two continued in the swampland.

Jaifer C. M. Herrin said Craft appeared at the Hinds County Jail, unarmed and unhurt, to give himself up. Dressed in U. S. Marine fatigue clothes, the war veteran and reputed ringleader in a series of shootings in a two-day racial disturbance in Smith County, said he had walked 60 miles to Jackson, the state capital.

Craft slipped through a heavily-armed posse of several hundred officers and citizens. The two men still at liberty are Garfield and Bill Craft, also said to be discharged veterans.
