

Finding Homes for Delinquents Hard Job for Aid Assn.

Finding families willing to care for and adopt delinquent youngsters is the problem of the Boys and Girls Aid Society of Oregon, said J. B. Fitzpatrick, field secretary for the society, who was in Roseburg Wednesday to confer with County Judge D. N. Busenbark.

Headquarters of the society are at Portland. Field secretaries work in all parts of the state to locate foster homes where the older boys and girls may be placed for adoption.

The society and other welfare agencies have no trouble in placing babies and younger children in homes with foster parents, as requests for children of these ages never cease.

Working in co-operation with juvenile judges and officers, public welfare commissions, and other agencies, the Boys and Girls Aid Society is primarily interested in older boys and girls who are "adoptable," usually those without tendencies toward juvenile delinquency.

Knotty Tasks Faced
Typical among those who are faced with the problems of child welfare, is the county judge who must decide what to do with a 10-year-old boy caught breaking into a service station and steal-

ing money, Fitzpatrick said.

The boy cannot be blamed for the traits born in him as an illegitimate son, not recognized by his father and abandoned by his mother. Too young to be sent to a corrective institution, he is considered "not adoptable," under usual standards, into foster homes.

Other problems met by the society include situations wherein unmarried mothers desire obstetrical care, aid for their children, or to offer their children for adoption.

"We are often against a blank wall when seeking a solution for these cases," Fitzpatrick said. "Our work puts on the ground floor the prevention of juvenile delinquency."

The Boys and Girls Aid Society is dependent upon the Oregon Chest for most of its funds used in carrying out its work. A portion of the Roseburg Community Chest, which begins October 16, will go to the Oregon Chest.
