## Rotarians' Code Topic of Address By Bruce Mellis

Rotarians in business should strive constantly toward the adoption of codes or standards of practice based upon the Rotary code of ethics in their professional or craft associations, the Roseburg Rotary Club was told Thursday by Bruce A. Mellis, chairman of the vocation service committee.

"To the non-Rotarian, a Rotarian is Rotary," he said. "The Rotarian in business is judged on how well he practices the Rotary code. It's definitely an individual responsibility to strive constantly for business service to society on high standards."

Rotary International, he explained, is based on a cross-section of business occupations, with more than 80 major classifications and almost 2,000 minor classifications.

George Marshall, in a five-minute talk, told of his "unprofitable" experience as a gold miner in Alaska and the Yukon, 40 years ago.
