Plant Faces Bill For Reservoir Tap

A mystery which has caused much controversy among Sutherlin residents during the past two weeks, having to do with the disappearance of approximately 2,000,000 gallons of water from the reservoir of that city, was solved Monday night by Sutherlin Mayor Henry Cook and the city council.

Reported as being drained and without water pressure several times during the past two weeks, the city reservoir was inspected Monday night by the municipal officials in a body for possible leaks, only to discover water from the main city line was being diverted without a permit into a nearby sawmill company's main mill pond.

Copco Granted Use of R.H.S. Field Transformer

The Roseburg School Board agreed at its meeting last Monday night to permit the California Oregon Power Company the use of the Finlay Field power transformer for use in supplying electricity to the new Coates Addition in West Roseburg for a period of five to six months.

Used to illuminate the local athletic field, the power unit, not replaceable at present, will be moved to the new residential section following the present high school football season and will be returned in time for summer baseball activities. The unit will provide electric power for 160 families, it was reported.

Other business at Monday night's meeting by the board was the endorsing of the Oregon Basic School Support Bill by all members.

All timber must be cut and removed within five years from date of approval of contract, the cutting and removal to be

carried out in accordance with the Forest Practice Rules approved July 7, 1938, by the Secretary of the Interior. Each bid must state the amount per thousand feet board measure, which will be paid for each species and the total consideration which will be paid for the timber. Each bid must be submitted in duplicate and be accompanied by a deposit of \$5,000.00 in the form of a certified check on a National Bank in favor of the Treasurer of the United States. The deposit will be returned to unsuccessful bidders; applied as part of the purchase price of successful bidders; or that portion of the deposit representing the minimum required by law to be deposited shall be retained as liquidated damages if the successful bidder shall not execute contract and furnish satisfactory bond within 30 days of the acceptance of his bid. Bond will be required in the amount of \$16,000.00. Payment for the timber will be required in advance of cutting, payable at the option of the purchaser, either in lump sum or in partial payments of not less than \$5,000.00 each, scheduled to keep pace with the rate of timber cutting and payable upon demand from the Chief Forester. The successful bidder will be required, prior to the approval of the contract, to furnish a sworn financial statement showing ability to fulfill the terms of the contract. For copies of the form of proposal, contract, bond, detailed timber estimates, cutting restrictions, and other information, application should be made to the Chief Forester, O. and C. Administration. All timber cut from the following described area must be manufactured in the local marketing area designated by the O. and C. Administration, unless otherwise authorized by the Chief Forester. If the unit prices bid are above those authorized by MPR 460, they will be reduced to the maximum permitted under that order. In case of two or more identical bids for the same timber, the successful bidder will be selected on the basis of comparative ability to produce immediately lumber for the Emergency Veterans Housing program and to further the objectives of the Act of August 28, 1937. The right is hereby reserved to waive technical defects in this advertisement; to reject all bids, or to award the timber for the amount of the highest bid to other than the successful bidder when necessary, pursuant to the Act of August 28, 1937 (50 Stat. 874), in order to provide a continued supply of timber to local industry so as to assure the permanence of the community which is dependent upon such industry.
