

Coos Office Will Handle Credit for Douglas Farmers

All Douglas county farm credit business, formerly cared for by the Farm Security Administration and the emergency crop and feed loan program, will now be served through the County Farmers' Home Administration Office.

Room 14, Bank Building, Coquille, announces Tollef Brudos, interim county FHA supervisor. "The Farmers Home Administration is authorized to make annual seed and feed loans as well as longer-time loans with farm and home plans for purchase of needed livestock, equipment, farm operating goods and assistance," Brudos said. "Forty-year farm ownership loans and special water facility loans are also continued under FHA. Eventually all former farm security and feed loan accounts will be consolidated in the FHA office, including all servicing and collections."

Production and operating loan limits, formerly \$2,500 under FSA and \$400 under ECFL, are set at \$3,500 for initial loans in any one year or a total indebtedness of not more than \$5,000 including principal and interest, Brudos explained. These loans cannot run more than 5 years and interest remains at 5 per cent. The interest rate on former farm ownership loans is raised from 3 to 3 1/2 per cent and broader authorities are given for farm development and improvements. Water facility loan terms are unchanged. "County Farmers Home Committees, consisting of three members, two of whom must be farmers, will continue to advise on eligibility of applicants' loan applications, as they did under FSA." Members of County FHA committee are Jay E. Young, Carl R. Holmquist and G. Charlie Doerner.

Applicants for FHA loans and former FSA and ECFL borrowers may secure detailed information on the new program at the county office every Monday, supervisor's office day, room 14, Bank Building, Coquille, from 8 A. M. until 5 P. M.
