**Prison Sentence Suspended After 11 Months in Jail**

ALBANY, Ore., Nov. 21.—(AP)—After 11 months in the Linn County jail, Jack Orville Mann was sentenced to three years imprisonment yesterday but sentence was suspended by Judge Victor Oliver during good behavior.

Mann pleaded guilty to burglary of an Albany confectionery store. He was arrested as a suspect in a Brownsville safe-cracking job and turned state's evidence against two others. One, Roy Moore, Portland, was convicted in the Brownsville case and the other, Douglas Day, alias S. D. McClain, died while the trial was in progress.

The case attracted wide attention because of a murder story which unfolded with it.

Multnomah County sheriff's deputies, questioning the men last December, said Mann reported that Day had shot a man on Dec. 18. Search for the victim followed, and on Jan. 18 the body of Ernest Bowman, Longview, Wash., logger, was recovered from Mary's River west of Corvallis.

Day, on the witness stand, admitted killing Bowman and said Mann conspired with him in planning the shooting, but Mann denied this. No charge arose from it.

**Bobby Doerr Able To Leave Hospital**

EUGENE, Ore., Nov. 21.—(AP)—Bobby Doerr, Boston Red Sox secondbaseman, was released from a local hospital today after being treated for a hand infection suffered while on his ranch in the remote Rogue River section of Illahe.

Doerr, wintering on his ranch on the Rogue after starring in the world series, collected a callous under the little finger of his left hand while spitting fence posts. The callous became infected and his hand and arm became swollen twice their normal size. He was brought to Eugene over a treacherous mountain road—only route to Illahe except by a 40-mile trip in a boat.

Arriving here Monday he was threatened by blood poisoning, but his physician, Dr. Harold Edlbloom, immediately operated and drained the puss from the infection. He received visitors for the first time yesterday—and one of his visitors was Joe Gordon, ex-New York Yankee and now Cleveland Indian secondbaseman, who is also a local resident.

Doerr will spend a few days with his wife's family at Cheshire, near here, before returning to Illahe.

**Submarine Takes Truman Under Sea**

KEY WEST, Fla., Nov. 21.—(AP)—President Truman went 440 feet down into the Atlantic today on a captured German submarine while his cabinet carried on a fight with John L. Lewis over the closing of the nation's soft coal mines.

While one of the most important battles of his own career transpired at Washington, the

president witnessed simulated battle problems from the control room while submerged at 440 feet, and from the conning tower while surfaced. He was the first president ever to submerge in a submarine.

His primary interest was in the "schnorkel," a two-way tube device which enables submarines to recharge their batteries while submerged.

This device, which provides both exhaust and intake for engines, was invented by the Germans toward the close of the war. Nearing perfection, its purpose was to keep submarines submerged for long periods on raiding operations.

As part of the simulated battle problems, a destroyer dropped two depth charge attacks on an imaginary target 2,000 yards off the beam. The explosions, which occurred while the submarine was surfaced, could be heard and felt aboard the U-boat which flew the president's own flag.
