economic sanctions to a direct appeal to Generalissimo Franco to get out, also made these specific recommendations:

1. That the Franco government

be barred from membership in any organization affiliated with the U. N. The present Madrid government already has been banned from the U. N. itself.
2. That if the Franco regime still remains in power after "a reasonable time," the security council consider "adequate measures" to remedy the situation.
The action was taken by a vote of 34 to 6, the negative votes coming from Argentina, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador and Peru.

State Board of Vocational Education wants \$881,155, against \$136,000 this biennium. About \$120,000 is wanted for vocational rehabilitation, or four times the amount for this biennium.
Here are a few more examples of what departments are getting this biennium, compared with what they want for the next biennium:

Department of Agriculture \$282,590 and \$488,760; Forest Research Laboratory \$48,370 and \$169,000; Forestry Department \$490,000 and \$726,000; State Board of Health \$305,000 and \$655,000; state police \$1,569,000 and \$1,941,000; state superintendent of public instruction \$144,000 and \$275,000; handicapped children's program \$200,000 and \$412,000; tax commission \$382,700 and \$919,906.

SALEM, Ore., Dec. 13.—(AP)—The Wilson River Highway was blocked by a slide today while there were several sections of one-way traffic on other roads in

storm-swept Northwest Oregon today, the State Highway Commission reported.
The Wilson River Highway slide is 16 miles east of Tillamook at Jordan Creek, and the commission said it hoped to have the route open this afternoon. There were other slides, 7, 9 and 20 miles east of Tillamook, causing one-way traffic restrictions around them.
There is a slide on the Sunset Highway 3 miles east of Elsie, with traffic restricted to one way. One-way traffic restrictions on the Oregon Coast Highway are at Neskawim Creek, where there are three washouts and a mud slide; 3 miles north and 2 miles south of Tillamook because of high water.
