

Recommendations For Net Fishing On Umpqua Drawn

Regulations recommended for commercial fishing on the Umpqua River by its biologists after a year's study of conditions on the stream were announced Wednesday by the State Fish Commission, which has approved the 1947 program and submitted it to the current state legislature in compliance with a directive issued at the 43d session of the Oregon lawmakers.

Following is a brief resume of the new regulations, which must be approved by the present legislature in order to become effective:

(a) November 16 to May 10, no commercial fishing. Reason: Protects the steelhead run and the spring Chinook run from the commercial fishery.

(b) May 10 to July 1 — Commercial fishing permitted at any hour with nets of 6 inches minimum mesh and 6-inch maximum. Provided that during this period one day of each week be closed to commercial fishing. Reason: Permits shad fishing during this period by delaying the opening of the shad season 20 days later than under present regulations, in order to give additional protection to the spring Chinook runs. However, since shad nets are of such small mesh and are made of very light twine, the incidental catch of adult Chinooks in shad nets is not great.

(c) July 1 to September 15 — Fishing permitted only from one hour before sunrise to one hour after sunset, with nets of minimum sized mesh of 7 inches. Reason: Permits striped bass fishing during this period, but prevents steelhead or salmon fishing, which can only be carried on successfully at night.

(d) September 15 to November 15 — Fishing permitted at any hour with nets of 7-inch minimum mesh size and 7-inch maximum. Provided that one day each week be closed to commercial fishing. Reason: Permits silver salmon fishing during this period, but prohibits the use of large-mesh net, which is more efficient for catching Chinooks.

(e) Fishing for, or possession of, sturgeon prohibited at all times.

Benefits Needed to Get Farm Labor, Conference Told

SALT LAKE CITY, Jan. 16. — (AP) — Extension of the Federal Security Act to farm workers, improved hospital service and better housing were urged as means to insure adequate future supplies of farm labor by William A. Schoenfeld of Corvallis, Ore.

Schoenfeld, deputy agriculture director at Oregon State College, told a 17-state farm labor conference of the U. S. Department of Agriculture yesterday steps must be taken to make agricultural work more attractive.

"Employer and employee in agriculture should resist declines in wages for farm work by increasing the efficiency of the individual worker, and in periods of high income * * * to pay bonuses for year-round workers. Some farmers," he said, "are already thinking of bonuses, as they are deductible from income taxes."

"We urged gradual adoption of labor saving devices to permit labor to adjust itself to new jobs."

"No high income period is in the foreseeable future," he warned the extension service and pro-

duction and marketing administration workers from Western states. "The demand for farm products will drop greatly as soon as we stop feeding people overseas."

Meredith C. Wilson, deputy director of extension, Washington, warned that the biggest job of recruiting workers for the coming year would be to bridge the gap caused by withdrawal of war prisoners and reduction of imported farm workers.

We must attract returned service men and war workers back into the farm fields," he said.

Huskies Trim Idaho Four In Row, Take Zone Lead

MOSCOW, Ida., Jan. 16. — (AP) — A clean sweep of four games over the University of Idaho, last year's champions, gave the Washington Huskies undisputed leadership today of the northern division Pacific Coast conference and left them one of the country's few major undefeated basketball teams.

The Huskies won their 12th straight, defeating Idaho last night, 69 to 49, after an amazing display of shooting enabled them to overcome an eight-point Idaho lead in the first half. Idaho held leads of 15-7, 19-11 and 21-13 before Washington speeded up and pulled ahead to lead at the half, 34-28.

Bob Jorgensen, Washington guard, scored six field goals in the second half and was the game's high scorer with 18 points. Washington has won four and lost none in conference play. It plays Washington State at Pullman Friday and Saturday nights.
