Howard Hughes Plans 2nd Plane Test Despite Crash

LOS ANGELES, Feb. 27.—(AP)—Howard Hughes, his associates say, is going to test fly another of the XP-11 experimental reconnaissance planes—of the type in which he almost died last summer. Hughes, who has long tested his company's planes on their initial flights, was forced to crash land the speedy craft last July and spent two months in a hospital. A spokesman said the second plane in the experimental series is ready for tests, and that approval is expected from the army air forces materiel command for Hughes to take it aloft within two weeks.
