Such a step appeared to be tied in closely with President Truman's declaration on America's new foreign policy aimed at halting the world march of communism, especially in the Balkans.

There was no indication just how far the American delegation to the United Nations has gone toward drawing up a plan for a permanent U. N. boundary commission. But authoritative sources said it was under consideration.

Meanwhile, top U. N. authorities considered President Truman's appeal to Congress for American aid to Greece and Turkey "too hot" for comment. It was met by what one informed source described as "apprehensive" silence.

Apparently speaking to forestall an expected Soviet attack on American zone denazification, Marshall read a statement relating that 12,000,000 persons have been registered for investigation, 200,000 tried and 370,000 removed from office in the U. S. section of Germany.

The secretary added that the American zone denazification went far beyond allied control authority directives, and asserted "there is nothing to conceal."

He pointed out allied control council had not received full reports on denazification in the eastern (Soviet) zone of Germany and added "my government opposes the use of denazification in favor of any political party."

BERLIN, March 13. — (AP) — American military government political officials said today that leaders of the Soviet-sponsored Socialist Unity party from Germany's Russian zone had met with little success in efforts to promote a Social Democratic Communist party merger in the United States zone.

These officials said that Communist Wilhelm Pieck and Social Democrat Otto Grotewohl, co-chairmen of the Socialist Unity party, now on a tour in the U. S. zone, had sought to arrange conferences with Socialist Democratic leaders to discuss deals for merger and cooperation with the Communists.

"Everywhere they have been given the cold shoulder by responsible Social Democrats," the officials reported.

Pear Harvest Cheaper
PORTLAND, March 13. — (AP) — It takes less workers to produce pears than it does apples, an Oregon State College survey in the Hood River valley showed today.

Labor requirements in apple orchards of the valley are 50 per cent higher than in pear orchards.

Mrs. Broadhurst's Case Nears Hands of Jury

VALE, Ore., March 13. — (AP) — The fate of Mrs. Gladys Broadhurst, 40, accused of plotting her husband's death, is expected to pass into the hands of a Circuit Court jury today.

Rival attorneys, now engaged in final arguments, were instructed by Judge M. A. Biggs to turn the case over to the jury by evening.

The state seeks the death penalty for the comely, red-haired woman who District Attorney Charles Swan said has been married seven times.

He accused her of converting the seventh husband, Alvin Lee Williams, 23-year-old cowboy, into a "love-sick slave" who killed W. D. Broadhurst, the sixth husband, so that she could get hold of Broadhurst's \$146,000 fortune.
