Anniversary of Submarine O. K. Observed Today

Friday, April 11, has been designated "Submarine Anniversary" according to L. J. Reinholdt of the Eugene U. S. Navy Recruiting office, as that is the day, 47 years ago, the U. S. Navy accepted the undersea boat as a new method of enforcing freedom of the seas.

Little publicized during the past war, the "Silent Service," the submarine service, an analytic view of the damage inflicted and the effect of that damage upon the enemy's power and will to resist shows that from December 7, 1941 to August 15, 1945 Allied submarines sank 1,750 Japanese steel merchant vessels. This was more than 56 per cent of the total of such losses.

Submarines sank one battleship, eight aircraft carriers, 15 cruisers, 42 destroyers, 28 submarines and 100 lesser war ships for a total of 194 combat vessels of all classes.

The price of achievement of submarines during the war was high as submarines lost more in percentage of total strength than any other branch of the service, land, sea or air. Combat operations took 49 ships with their officers and men.

Sexy Staging of Shakespeare Play Stirs Up Tempest

STRAFFORD-ON-AVON, Eng., April 10. —(AP)—A frankly sexy production of "Romeo and Juliet" by a company of young people in or barely out of their teens has stirred up a tempest in Shakespeare's birthplace.

Opening the annual Shakespeare festival in the Memorial theater, 21-year-old Producer Peter Brook and his 18-year-old Juliet, pretty Daphne Slater, drew withering blasts from England's gray-haired drama critics. "Recklessly spectacular," thundered the London Times. The Manchester Guardian said Shakespeare seemed to be "fighting a losing battle against his determined producer."

Miss Slater's Juliet fared even worse. London's Daily Telegraph dismissed her as "a veritable junior miss." The Daily Express said she "will infuriate everyone over 35 who has seen great — and much older — actresses play the part."

Miss Slater, calmness itself after the passionate balcony scene, commented:

"I am not trying to play Juliet as a glamorous film star."

She is a little southern girl swept off her feet by a series of wonderful and terrible events."

Michigan, Illinois Vets Advised To Write Anent Bonus

Veterans who lived in Illinois or Michigan before the war are advised to write their former state capitals for information regarding bonus payments to personnel who served in World War I.

The Illinois bonus amounts to \$10 per month for active service in the United States and \$15 for each month of foreign service including Alaskan duty, with a minimum payment of \$50 to those with a minimum of 60 days' service. Next of kin of those who died in line of duty are eligible to receive \$800. The Illinois compensation act states. The veteran must have been a resident of Illinois at time of entry into service, according to the act. Applications are being received by the Illinois Veterans Commission, 223 E. Monroe St., Springfield, Illinois. Deadline for filing is July 1, 1949.

Michigan makes the same monthly domestic and foreign duty payments, but provides a maximum of \$800 for either qualified veterans or their dependents. The veteran must have been a Michigan resident for six months prior to entry into service.

Operation Spurred By Gypsy as Tribe Roams Hospital

TACOMA, April 10. —(AP)—The usually quiet halls of the Tacoma General Hospital swarmed today with an unaccustomed and colorful sight — several dozen gaily-dressed Gypsies who have almost virtually taken over the place while a member of their band fights without surgical aid — an attack of appendicitis.

Steve Ephraim, 53, was brought to the hospital Sunday night in a limousine, and with him came the others. Ephraim refused to permit surgery, asking only that his hand be permitted to visit him. At night the Gypsies sleep in their automobiles parked in the street in front of the hospital. At daylight they enter the building, swarm through its halls or loiter upon the green lawns.

Doctors say Ephraim's condition is "satisfactory," but that there is little to be done for him unless he and the clan decide to permit surgery — which they have thus far steadfastly refused to consider although they have been informed it may cost the Gypsy his life.

Pressure Gauge Tests At O. S. C. Suspended

Whiskey-Short Scots Again 'See' Monster of Lake

INVERNESS, Scotland, April 10. —(AP)—Despite the shortage of Scotch whiskey, some people are reporting seeing the Loch Ness monster again. (North Scotland's 1947 tourist season is just starting.)

To hear them tell it, the thing swooshes through the long narrow lake as fearfully as ever. So much for the wartime claim of Mussolini's propaganda staff that a direct bomb hit had destroyed the Loch Ness nightmare. The monster was first reported "seen" in 1933, but was coyly out of sight during most of the war.

J. W. McKillop, Inverness-Shire county clerk, said he sighted it this week. "The monster was traveling diagonally across the Loch," related McKillop, a sober man. "It travelled at high speed to the other side and submerged about 200 yards off the shore."

Four men in an automobile, drinking habits unknown, also insisted they saw Nessie, as local residents call the monster.
