Benson's Hurling Leads Indians to Win Over Medford

With Bill Benson, righthander, pitching almost hitless ball, Roseburg's Indians downed the Medford Tigers by a score of 7 to 2 at Finlay Field yesterday, qualifying them for a playoff with Klamath Falls to decide the Southern Oregon representative at the state playoffs in Portland.

Roseburg experienced its first defeat in an exhibition contest following their victory, bowing heavily to the Tigers 5 to 0.

The conference victory gave the Indians a clean sweep of season play, leaving only Grants Pass on the list for next Tuesday at the Camerun City. The result, however, will have no bearing on Roseburg's standing at the top of the heap.

Trailing 2-0 until the fourth frame, when Edgar and Keene crossed the plate off a hit by Scofield and a Medford error, the Indians knocked the bottom out of the contest in the sixth frame by scoring four runs, making the count 7 to 2. Benson allowed only two hits for Medford's only scores, while Roseburg hit Chies for nine and seven runs. Roseburg misplayed once to the Tigers' five.

In the nightcap, an exhibition contest, Mel Ingram's crew showed great signs of fatigue as Medford took off on a three-point lead in the second frame, held the Indians to three hits and added two more scores in the sixth.

The bodies of both Mrs. Atkins and her infant son have been removed to the Long & Orr Mortuary. Funeral arrangements will be announced later.



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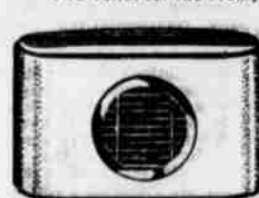
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
