

Social Hygiene Topic of Talk at Health Assn. Meet

Dr. F. G. Scherer of the division of Social Hygiene Education of the Oregon Tuberculosis Association, Portland, was guest speaker at the 26th annual meeting of the Douglas County Public Health Association held at a 12 o'clock luncheon at the Methodist Church Wednesday. Dr. Scherer explained the work of this newly formed department of social hygiene education of the association and urged that all residents of the entire state learn of its work. In years past, Dr. Scherer stated, doctors and associations of health had worked ceaselessly to cure diseases of every type and only in the recent years have efforts been made strenuously to prevent disease. The work of this new department is to educate the people in the prevention of all kinds of disease. Numerous pamphlets and other types of literature have been prepared by the new department and which will be available to all persons interested. The materials may be secured by writing the Social Hygiene Education division, Oregon Tuberculosis Association, 605 Woodlark Building, Portland, or by calling at the Douglas County Public Health Association office in the Pacific Building.

Representatives from every civic organization, a number of lodges, churches, schools, R. T. A.'s and clubs throughout the entire county were present and introduced by Mrs. H. A. Watzig, president. Special guests were the members of Mrs. Cyrus' Camp Fire group, who have assisted the association in numerous projects during the year.

At the last annual meeting of the association, the members were endeavoring to secure a permanent sanitarian for Douglas County, a fact realized last November, when Claude Baker was employed to serve the county in this capacity. Mr. Baker outlined the work accomplished by his department since last fall.

Dr. E. J. Wainwright presented his staff and Mrs. Watzig introduced the executive secretary, Mrs. W. F. Arnot, and the County Seal Seal Chairman, Mrs. R. M. Church.

New officers unanimously elected to serve for the coming year included: Mrs. Hedwig Watzig, president; Mrs. O. L. Frey, Secretary; Mrs. J. E. Snyder, first vice-president; Mrs. John Edwards, Oakland, second vice-president; Mrs. Fritz Snyder, Days Creek, third vice-president; Mrs. Hugh Whipple, Drain, fourth vice-president; Mrs. Wallace Ferguson, Sutherlin, secretary; and Mrs. Ray S. Petrequin, Roseburg, treasurer.

Announcement was made that the Washington and Oregon state Tuberculosis Associations will hold a joint meeting in Portland, June 3-4. The National Association meeting will be held in San Francisco, June 18. All persons interested are invited to attend both sessions.

Many Applicants For Army Entry Fail to Pass Test

Men accepted now for the Regular Army, under new, high physical and intelligence requirements, are a "select group" consisting of approximately the top 50 per cent of all applicants, according to a statistical report from the War Department received at the Roseburg Army Recruiting Station, M/Sgt. Charles Needels, station commander, said.

Sixteen per cent of rejections resulted from failure of applicants to pass preliminary aptitude and intelligence tests. Eleven per cent were unable to meet the physical standards. Moral and literacy requirements proved the stumbling block for the remainder, the sergeant stated.

Sgt. Needels said he is calling upon local citizens, as well as civic and fraternal organizations, to assist the Army in securing applicants of the high calibre needed to maintain a peacetime technical army.

These citizens and organizations will be furnished with "Certificates of Recommendation" entitling the young men of their selection to a qualification interview.

The sergeant pointed out that the starting pay in the Army is the equivalent to \$211.50 per month, exclusive of the liberal educational and retirement benefits.

Qualification interviews for men who have received a recommendation will be held daily at the Army Recruiting Station in the Roseburg Armory, Needels added.

**Post to Sponsor Boys
For 'State' Encampment**
Civic organizations and fraternal groups are joining with the American Legion, Umpqua Post, No. 16, to sponsor several boys for the annual Beaver Boys State to be held at Corvallis, June 29 to July 6.

Purpose of the summer encampment is to acquaint boys with state, county, and city government. They will elect their own mayors, city councilmen, county officials, and state officers for a model government.

Candidates for Beaver Boys State must be 15 years of age or older and must have an "outstanding" record in citizenship and good conduct. Selections will be made from the recommendations of school principals, teachers, and business men.
