NOTICE OF SPECIAL CITY ELECTION CITY OF RIDDLE, OREGON
NOTICE is hereby given that the Common Council of the City of Riddle, Oregon, has by Ordinance No. 106, passed by the Common Council and approved by the Mayor May 26th, 1947, called a special election of the qualified voters of the City of Riddle, Oregon, which election will be held in said City on Friday the 27th day of June, 1947, the purpose of which is to determine the question of authorizing the Common Council of said City to issue and sell general obligation bonds of said City in the sum of \$20,000.00 for the purpose of providing funds for the improvement and repair of the City's Water System, by the construction of a Pump House, purchasing and installing equipment, constructing a chlorinating house, purchasing and installing chlorinating equipment, purchasing and installing all necessary water pipe and fittings therefor, repairing the reservoir and water mains, purchasing the necessary sites upon which to construct the pump and chlorinating houses, said bonds to mature initially and bear interest at not to exceed 4% per annum, payable semi-annually.

The term in which said proposal shall appear on the official ballot of said election shall be as follows:
PROPOSED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL
Shall the City of Riddle, Oregon, issue and sell general obligation bonds of said City in the sum of \$20,000.00, to be sold in serials and to bear interest at not to exceed 4% per annum, payable semi-annually, said bonds to be issued and sold for the purpose of providing funds for the improvement and repair of the City's Water System, by constructing a pump house, purchasing and installing pumping equipment, constructing a chlorinating house, purchasing and installing chlorinating equipment, purchasing and installing all necessary water pipe and fittings therefor, purchasing sites upon which to construct pump and chlorinating houses, repair reservoir and water mains of present water system.
