The coroner quoted Merle Trachsel as saying "hoate told him he had a 'surprise' cut a stick with which to pull the trigger, placed the muzzle of a shotgun against his chest and fired. Trachsel was quoted as saying he thought the elaborate preparations were part of the joke.
