Physical Exams Set for Bluebirds, Camp Fire Girls

Physical examinations for Roseburg Camp Fire Girls and Bluebirds who are attending Camp Kilowan, July 2 to 9, will be held at the county health office Friday, June 27, and Tuesday July 1, according to Mrs. Frances Ellison, local council president.

Members of the Tawanka, Mari-copa and Iwa Camp Fire groups

and Benson and Fullerton Bluebird groups will report between 9:30 A. M. and 12 Noon or 1:30 to 5 P. M. Friday. Examinations for the Umpqua, Tawanka, Cheskema-may Camp Fire groups and Rose Bluebirds will be held the same hours Tuesday.

Parents of girls attending camp are asked to note, Mrs. Ellison said, that a physical examination is necessary for entrance to camp. If unable to attend the examination on the day scheduled, their daughters should be sure to attend the alternate day, in order that the health blank may be filled in by Dr. E. J. Waincott, county health officer.

Girls are asked to bring the remainder of their camp fee, \$11.50 and \$3 for transportation, to the health office where it will be collected by guardians in attendance.

The school buses will leave the Junior High School at 6:30 Wednesday for Camp Kilowan, Luther Ellison, driver, stated. Girls are asked to bring their luggage and bedroll, also a lunch Wednesday morning as no lunch will be served at camp upon arrival.

Unions Facing Many 'Musts' in New Labor Law

WASHINGTON, June 24.—(AP)—Final passage of the Taft-Hartley bill yesterday made it the law that unions:

May be sued by employers for breach of contract and for damages in jurisdictional strikes and secondary boycotts.

Are required by law to bargain collectively with employers.

May not compel employers to hire only union members, but still may enter into agreement providing that all employees join the union under certain conditions.

May not bargain for foremen and supervisors.

May not require employers to deduct union dues from any envelopes unless the workers agree.

Lose their rights under the Wagner act if any officer is a Communist or active sympathizer.

May not make certain contributions and expenditures for political purposes.

Are forbidden to engage in certain practices held "unfair."

It also is the law now that the government:

May get injunctions against unions to stall off for 80 days a strike which would affect the national health or safety.

Set up a new conciliation service outside the Labor Department.

Enlarge the National Labor Relations Board from three to five members and overhaul the way it works.

Establish a 14-member Senate-House committee to study labor-management relations.

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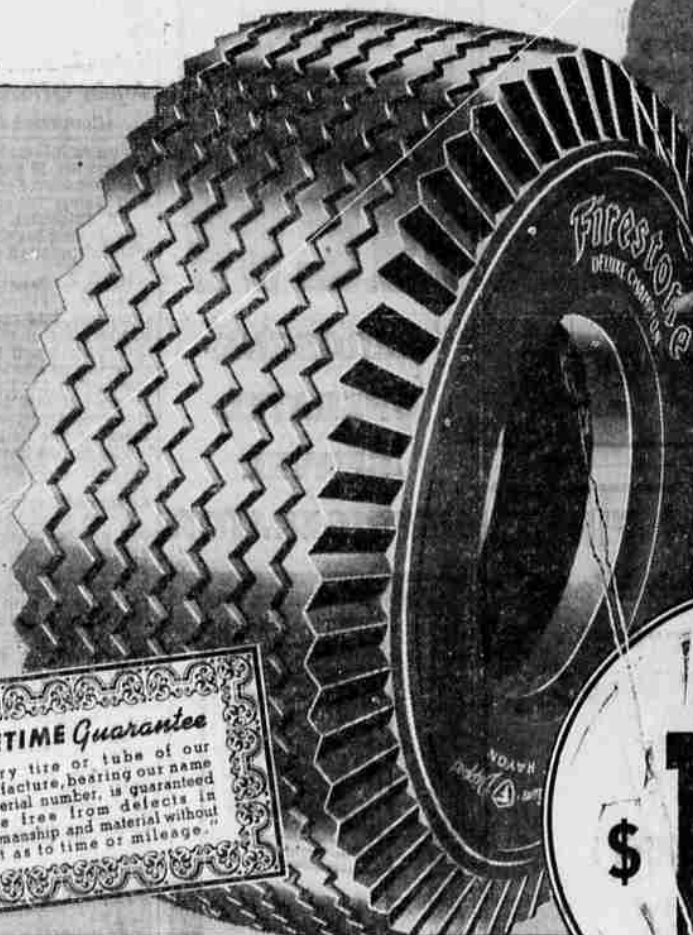
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
