New Housing Law Covers Rent Fees And Overcharges

Specific protection against evictions are contained in the new
Rent and Housing Act, E. Daryl
Mabee, of the Douglas County
Defense-Rental Area, point out.

These eviction controls will be
enforced by the local courts under
local law. A landlord will
have to go into his local court
in order to evict the tenant, and
the courts will decide whether
the grounds for eviction are legally
sufficient under local law.

Previously, the waiting period
for evicting a tenant ranged
from four to six months. The
waiting period now will be the
length of time allowed under
State law.

Evictions to allow occupancy
by others are limited by the new
federal laws to the immediate
personal occupancy by the buyer
or the landlord himself. A land-
lord may no longer evict a ten-
ant because his mother or sister
or brother are in need of hous-
ing accommodations. Other con-
ditions under which evictions
may be made are very specific
under the new rent law.

The tenant who continues to

pay the rent to which the land-
lord is entitled and lives up to
the obligations of the tenancy
generally has no more reason to
fear eviction than before, Mabee
said.

The new law provides that a
tenant who has been overcharged
may file in any federal or state
court within one year after viola-
tion for three times the amount
of the overcharge, plus reason-
able attorneys fees and costs.

The housing expediter is em-
powered to secure injunctions in
federal or state courts against
persons who offer, demand or re-
ceive rent in excess of the per-
missible maximum rent allowed
for the housing accommodations.

Defense, Victory Medals Ready for Navy Duty Vets

American Defense and World
War II Victory Medals for all
veterans of the Naval Services
who qualify are now available.
It was reported by 13th Naval
District Headquarters, Seattle.

All veterans who served on
active duty at any time between
Dec. 7, 1941, and Dec. 31, 1946,
and who were separated from the
service with an honorable
discharge or a discharge under
honorable conditions, are eligible
for these medals. It was empha-
sized, however, that no medals
will be issued prior to August 1.

Eligibility will be determined
only upon presentation of one of
the following documents:

1. Honorable Discharge Certificate (NavPers-500).
2. Under Honorable Conditions Discharge Certificate issued prior July 1, 1947, NavPers-601.
3. General Discharge Certificate (NavPers-601).
4. Certificate issued by the Navy Department in lieu of the foregoing type discharge certificates.

For Fleet Reservists, Retired Personnel and personnel released to inactive duty after active service during World War II, a certified copy of orders releasing the individual to inactive duty. This does not include orders releasing an individual to inactive duty incident to enlistment or reenlistment in the peace-time Naval Reserve.

Officer Personnel: Certified copy of orders releasing officer to inactive duty under honorable conditions.

2. An authorized Naval representative may accept the original of Notice of Separation from the Naval Service (NavPers-553) only in cases where eligible applicants have satisfactorily explained the unavailability of documents referred to above. NavPers-553 must establish applicant's separation from service under honorable conditions.

Local Naval veterans may make application for these medals at any main Navy recruiting station, sub-recruiting station, or nearest Naval Reserve activity. A Navy recruiting office is located at Eugene, and a Naval Reserve unit is headquartered in Roseburg.

Qualifying applicants may apply by mail, but the actual delivery of medal or medals must be made directly to the applicant through one of the activities listed above.

Posthumous awards of all medals will be made by the Bureau of Naval Personnel, Navy Department, Washington 25, D. C.

Personnel entitled to these medals because of service with the Army, Marine Corps, or Coast Guard may apply for them in accordance with instructions issued by these services. For detailed information they are advised to communicate with their nearest activity of the branch of service concerned.

Impersonation of Navy Officer Charged to Man

LOUISVILLE, Ky., July 15—(AP)—M. W. McFarlin, special agent in charge of the Louisville Federal Bureau of Investigation office, today announced the arrest in Paducah, Ky., of a man listed as William Crump, 35, on a charge of impersonating a Navy intelligence officer in Seattle, Wash.

McFarlin said Crump would be returned to Seattle for questioning. He said Crump, who has no permanent home address, had been involved in an automobile accident at Spokane, Wash., and had presented credentials of a Navy officer which proved false.

Earnings of Telephone Company Show Decline

NEW YORK, July 16—(AP)—American Telephone & Telephone Co. yesterday reported net income for the quarter ended June 30 of \$32,000,000, equal to \$1.55 a capital share, compared with \$44,883,380 in the like 1946 quarter.

For 12 months ended June 30 the net income was placed at \$180,760,000 or \$8.87 a share against \$170,604,913 or \$8.91 a share in the preceding 12 months.

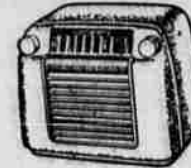

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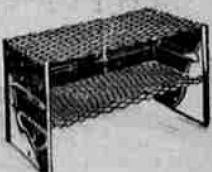
