

Europe Will Need Aid for Some Time, Harriman States

SEATTLE, Aug. 20.—(AP)—Expressing faith in the economic recovery of Europe, Secretary of Commerce, Henry C. Harriman, declared here yesterday that "there is no doubt in my mind that Europe can increase its productivity."

Coal, he asserted, is the most important factor in helping Europe get on its feet. He said the United States will have to continue exporting coal and heavy machinery for production for some time to come.

The secretary emphasized that the extreme 1946-47 winter in Europe had a "terrible effect" in delaying production. Alluding to the phrase, "shortage of dollars," Harriman said he believed that a world shortage of productivity would be a more correct term.

He said he looked forward to the day when private capital would feel safe in investing abroad. He added he had been heartened during conversations with many people throughout the nation by the fact that most of them seemed convinced that the United States could not remain prosperous while great portions of the world remained prostrate.

With regard to domestic production, he said production had caught up with demand in some industries and that as it increased in others, inflation tendencies would likely be controlled.

Harriman declared that the United States must do business with Japan if we are to obtain our objectives in that country. He said Japan must have imports in order to exist.

He added however that he was not in favor of exporting "unless we can see how we are going to get paid for it."

Driver Course Beckons High School Students

High school students who have never driven an automobile and are old enough to obtain learner's permits may enroll in a driver training course to be offered at Roseburg High School this year, Superintendent of Schools Paul S. Elliott said.

Instructor will be Alva Laws, who has returned from a "very intensive" driving school sponsored by the State Board of Higher Education and Oregon Motor Association at Portland. Ninety-four persons from Oregon, Washington, California, and Montana took the course, he said.

Five manuals issued by American Automobile Association will be used as textbooks, as well as the Oregon Drivers Manual. The manuals are: "How to Drive," "The Driver," "Sound Driving Practices," "Driver and Pedestrian Responsibilities," and "Society's Responsibilities."

Creswell Wife Accused Of Murdering Husband

EUGENE, Ore., Aug. 20.—(AP)—Mrs. Helen Rookard, 29, Tuesday was conferring with her attorney after arraignment here on charges of second degree murder in connection with the death of her husband, Walter, 42.

Mr. Rookard died Monday morning in a Eugene hospital. An autopsy Monday night fixed the cause of death as gunshot wounds in the abdomen.

The shooting occurred in the couple's Creswell home Sunday night. The murder charge was filed by District Attorney Ed Luckey.

At her arraignment, Mrs. Rookard was informed that a preliminary hearing will be scheduled at a later date. She is held in the county jail.
