Having spent four days in what, to our provincial mind, is the most beautiful spot on the entire North American continent—the North Umpqua country and Diamond Lake—we find that the outstanding impression of the trip concerns FOOD.

What a difference from the time, seemingly only a few years ago, when all we could find to eat in that same country was what we packed on our backs, as we toiled over dusty trails, or the game we could kill, or fish we could catch!

But, brother, if you want to put your feet under a table loaded down with good food prepared to the nth degree of culinary proficiency, you have only to grab an invitation to the mess hall at Big Camas Ranger Station, the heart of the Umpqua forest, where Mrs. Gertrude Martin, a school-teacher at Riddle, assisted by her daughter, Alice, presides over the kitchen.

Out in that vast, beautiful country, where we have tramped many weary, sweaty miles under the steadily increasing weight of a bedding roll and the skimpiest of rations, and where a "bull" camp's menu was uniformly and monotonously boiled beans, sowbely and stewed prunes, we now find ordinary work camps where men are fed meals which would make a restaurant famed throughout the nation.

At Diamond Lake, where our earliest recollections are of mosquito infested camps accessible only by pack trails, or over what passed as a road—being two wagonwheel ruts through a dusty wilderness—one finds a thoroughly modern resort, with well furnished cabins, a lodge where hotel rooms compare most favorably with those to be found in any metropolitan hostelry and a dining room with superb culinary and table service.

It is a wonderland belonging to Oregon but discovered by California, as attested by the parking rail at Diamond Lake resort where of sixteen cars in a row only one carried an Oregon license.

Mize on Way To Shattering Ruth's Home Run Record

Mize has 44 to his credit counting his circuit clout yesterday which enabled the Giants to defeat the Cardinals for the second straight time, 6-5, and plummet the Redbirds' down to seven games in back of the Dodgers. He needs 17 more to establish a new mark.

Mize currently is five games ahead of the pace Ruth set in his record breaking 1927 season. The Dodgers gained a full game on the Redbirds by defeating the Cubs, 6-2. They finished off Wyse with four runs in the first inning.
