ments in the afternoon time schedule will be made for 1st, 2nd and 3rd grades. This is caused by limited transportation facilities.

Hot Lunches Included

Hot lunches will be served in all schools except Sylmon Valley beginning Monday and will continue daily thereafter. The cost for lunches will be 20 cents for elementary pupils per day and 25 cents at Junior and Senior High Schools. Tickets will be available in case pupils wish to buy for several days in advance. The lunch program will begin at the same price as last year, and it is hoped that through federal assistance, it will not be necessary to increase the cost per meal, Elliott said.

The elementary schools, grades 1 to 6, will be confined to the following districts for the first day or two until adjustments can be made according to facilities available:

Rose School will enroll all pupils south of Deer Creek and east of the Umpqua River with the exception of the territory west of the railroad on Oak street.

Fullerton School will enroll all pupils from Umpqua Park and

West Roseburg in grades 1 to 6, except those in grades 1, 2 and 3 West Broccoli Lane, which passes by Shinn's Hatchery. Those students will report to Sylmon Valley School the first day. Some adjustment will then be made when the actual enrollment is known.

Benson School will enroll all pupils from grades 1 to 6 north of Deer Creek and east of the railroad.

"The school population has shifted during the summer months so that it may require a few days to make the necessary adjustments to equalize grades and facilities throughout the system," Elliott said.

Annexation Favored to Solve Sewage Problem

will finance the proposed bond issue.

Alternatives would be to (1) Finance sanitary improvements by annual tax levies over a period of years; (2) organize the district to test the feasibility of a bond issue; (3) form a separate municipality which would have authority to issue bonds; or (4) annexation to the City of Roseburg.

VA Would Use Plant

Todd said he had been advised by the Seattle construction office of the Veterans Administration that plans are being prepared for a sewage treatment plant to be erected on the Roseburg Veterans Hospital grounds. VA rules, however, prevent construction of such installations jointly by the government and local bodies.

If, however, the sanitary district is also planning the construction of a sewage treatment plant, the VA would be willing to pay for use of the plant on an average monthly flow basis.

State Representative Robert C. Gile, appraiser in the county assessor's office, told the meeting that valuation of the Roseburg Rural Fire District is approximately \$1,600,000. He said he favored creation of a sanitary district comprising the entire fringe area outside the city or, preferably, annexation.

"Todd asked, 'If we come into the city, when do we get our sanitation?'"

Contingent Plans Favored

Gile suggested that two measures appear on the annexation ballot, each contingent upon the other. One measure would provide for a bond issue, should voters favor annexation of outlying areas to the city.

Mayor Albert G. Flegel told the meeting that he favored annexation of suburban areas to the city. He explained that a successful vote would depend upon the sentiment of persons both within and without the city. He added that many persons have moved to nearby rural areas to escape the costs and obligations of living in the city.

Flegel summoned City Councilman Percy Croft by telephone to attend the meeting, to explain the problems of issuing bonds, which would be necessary to finance any improvements by the city in newly-acquired areas.

U. S. Acts to Speed Plan For Korean Independence

was agreed the United States and Russia should form a joint commission to unify Korea and that control should be exercised by the Big Four powers for five years after establishment of a stable native administration.

Further Delay Useless

The note continued: "The present stalemate in the joint commission negotiations and the failure of that commission to accomplish even the first task of its commission have made it abundantly clear to all that bi-lateral negotiations on the subject of consultation with Korean political parties and organizations will only serve to delay the implementation of this agreement and defeat its announced purpose of bringing about early independence for Korea."

The demand for a four-power conference follows two unsuccessful attempts to settle Korea's political future through bi-lateral

talks. As it now stands, the country is divided with Russia occupying the northern half and the United States in charge in the south.
