### Piano Prodigy To Go Back to Mother

SAN FRANCISCO, Jan. 30.—(AP)—Jacqueline Horner, 15-year-old runaway from Hollywood prominence and piano exercises, has been made a ward of the juvenile court and, today, was reluctantly awaiting transportation home.

Juvenile authorities said the pretty piano prodigy would be returned to her mother, Mrs. Clara Horner, as soon as transportation could be arranged.

She was found in San Francisco Jan. 21 after an eight-day search. Police located Jackie in a hotel room with 19-year-old Wallace Wells of Hood River, Ore., a navy seaman. The two told authorities they had done nothing wrong. Investigators agreed.

Wells, accused in superior court of contributing to the delinquency of a minor, was released to the navy by Judge L. L. Harris, who said both were "just children."

### Welfare Service Position Filled

Miss Helen Gorrell was recently employed by the Douglas County Public Welfare Commission as a caseworker. It was announced by Mrs. Lois Baker, county welfare administrator.

Miss Gorrell, graduate of the University of Oregon, was employed for 15 months by the commission. Later, she joined the Lane County Public Welfare Commission as a caseworker and during the recent war, served three years with the Red Cross in Australia, the Philippines and Korea. Miss Gorrell recently returned to Roseburg from employment with the United Nations at Lake Success, N. Y.

Mrs. Baker stated that the employment of Miss Gorrell makes better welfare service possible for Douglas County. There is still a need for additional caseworkers, however, she said.

Applicants must have had two years of college in addition to two years of public service, or have been graduated from a four-year college or university.

Miss Gorrell announced the employment of Mrs. Dorothy Nelson as a stenographer with the commission. Mrs. Jeanette Vaughn, receptionist, has returned to her duties after a brief illness.

### Credit Union Organized By Roseburg Teachers

At a recent meeting of Roseburg school teachers, Hugh G. Stout, manager of the Portland Teachers Credit Union, and W. O. Wright, examiner of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corp., were present to explain the plan and organization of a teachers' credit union.

Following the meeting, Stanley Glick was appointed temporary secretary and a committee chosen to lay plans for a local teachers' credit union. As soon as a charter is received, a meeting will be held at which time officers will be elected.

All teachers and employees of school districts in Douglas County will be eligible for membership in the Roseburg Teachers Credit Union.

Set up with a social motive as a purpose, a credit union affords a means for savings and a source of credit when loans are needed.

### Eckhardt Named As Deputy Sheriff

Appointment of Arthur "Red" Eckhardt, Roseburg, as deputy sheriff for the Reedsport area, was announced today by Sheriff O. T. Carter. Eckhardt is leaving immediately for Reedsport to establish residence. He will take over his new duties Feb. 1, replacing Al Smith, who resigned from the sheriff's staff.

A resident of Roseburg for the past nine years, following purchase of a ranch which he has operated near Medford, Eckhardt has been local agent for the Oregon-Nevada-California Fast Freight Line for the past three years.

He is a native of Portland, Oregon, and has made his home in Oregon almost exclusively, except for a period of three years with the San Francisco police force as a special officer, during which time he also worked with the office of the Deputy U. S. Marshall. Eckhardt also has had experience as a government law enforcement officer in Oregon.

He has resigned from his position with the freight line, effective today.

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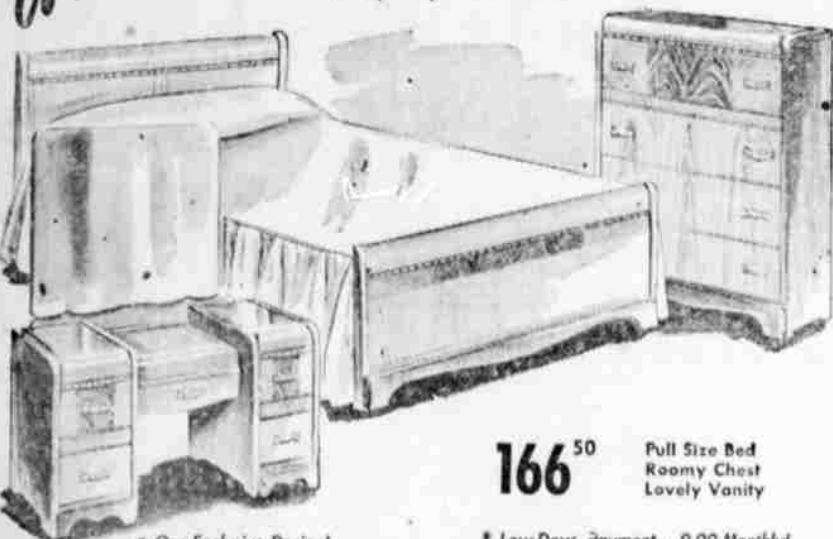
