Eugene H. Fisher, president of the association, will preside and introduce the speakers, including Arnold Anderson, regional manager of the Federal Land Bank of Spokane.

A brief business session will be highlighted by a report by Strickie on the progress of the local farmer-owned credit institution, and the showing of a sound motion picture, "Banking on the Land," which has been especially prepared by the Federal Land Bank.

Two directors are to be elected. The terms of J. H. Parrott, Camas Valley, and Chas. S. Dyar expire this year. Hold-over directors are Eugene H. Fisher, Kellogg; Lawrence Michaels, Canyonville; W. G. Truitt, Oakland, and Emery Baker, Brockway.

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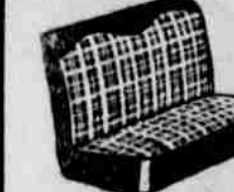
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
