Bandits Get \$40,000 in Loot in Home of Banker—PHILADELPHIA, Feb. 18.—(AP)—Caleb F. Fox, Jr., socially prominent Philadelphia banker and sportsman, was robbed of \$40,000 in valuables by four masked bandits who invaded his home in suburban Rydal last night, police reported.

The thugs herded the seven persons in the house into a bedroom, tied them up with strips torn from bed sheets and left them there while they ransacked the house.

They found mink and beaver fur coats, diamond and sapphire bracelets, rings, necklaces and watches valued by Fox at around \$25,000. They also took silverware and other valuables.

But at DOROTHY'S, conspicuous at 115 S. Stephens St., the impressions are fresh and vivid, so to avoid any hushed-over conclusions go direct to the store and collect your own first-hand information.

Now hanging right across the back of the front section of the store (I hope you follow me) are some of the most beautiful impressions that ever charmed a retina. Impressions, that is, of famous original paintings by contemporary artists, running about 23 x 27 inches in size, and framed in simple gold frames. You'll get an optical exhilaration just from looking at these pictures and, after all, the ultimate purpose of a picture is to stimulate the senses. A snow clad peak reflected in a clear mountain lake conjures up a summer vacation with trout on the line. A lush meadow scene with kind knees deep in June brings to mind the cool colorful country of our lost childhood. A high desert panorama with foot hills in the distance waits the scent of sage to the nostrils. Crags, rugged rocks, fields and streams in delicate tints or deep rich pigments form a felicitous feast for the eyes, and all at DOROTHY'S, where the looking is luscious, yet.
