Daylight savings will go into effect in California March 15, principally as a result of severe drought conditions in that state, which have brought about a reduction in the generative capacity of the state's electric power system. H. C. Wells, manager of the California-Oregon Power Co. here, said he has received figures from California showing that the Pacific Gas and Electric System would save an estimated 136 million kilowatt hours for the season, or about 8 or 9 per cent of its power load.

Daylight savings were adopted in Oregon, he added, the reduction in power use would probably be in the same proportion. Representatives of the California-Oregon Power Co., which purchases wholesale power from California, were to meet in Fresno, Calif., today to discuss the daylight savings plan with representatives of several other power companies.

Hickerson said sentiment of a majority of business men in Roseburg apparently favors the daylight savings plan and they will urge its adoption on a statewide basis. Iris Hellwell, manager of KRRR, said that several network program difficulties will arise unless daylight savings is adopted on a statewide basis. Several regional and national network broadcasts are fed into the Don Lee network from California, where daylight savings will be adopted. Confusion will result if Oregon remains on standard time, because coast network broadcasts from California would be heard here an hour earlier than usual.
