

Wages Stressed By Speakers At Employees Meet

Meeting of the Roseburg chapter of the Oregon State Employees Association at the Knights of Pythias Hall Thursday night was highlighted by informative talks by Loren White, president of the state association, and Forrest V. Stewart, executive secretary.

White laid emphasis on the fact that the association is "really getting someplace as an organization" and has done much to improve conditions of employment and wages for all state workers. He pointed out that O. S. E. A. was responsible "in large measure" for securing the retirement plan and Civil Service, which offers a considerable degree of security to state workers.

"There is yet much to be accomplished," he said. "The key to the salary problem is the legislature. Sixty-three per cent of state workers now earn less than \$200 per month." White asserted that Gov. John Hall is "disappointed" at this condition of inadequate compensation and is endeavoring to find some means of meeting the emergency between

now and the next session of the legislature.

Stewart discussed at some length the matter of preparation for the legislative session to "protect the rights that have been made for state workers" and the merit rating system, which needs a lot of work and is recognized as a difficult problem. Another speaker securing the attention of O. S. E. A., as well as other interested groups, he said, is the matter of Civil Service examinations, of which few have been given to date.

Coffee and doughnuts were served following adjournment by James W. Vaughn, president of the local chapter. Fifty-one persons were in attendance.

National Forest Timber for Sale

Oral auction bids will be received at the office of the Forest Supervisor, Post Office Building, Roseburg, Oregon, beginning at 2:00 P. M., April 6, 1948, for all the live timber marked or designated for cutting, and all merchantable dead timber located on an area embracing about 2190 acres within Sections 27, 28, 29, 31, 32, 33 and 34, T. 28 S., R. 2 E., and Section 6 T. 29 S., R. 2 E., W.M., unsurveyed, Umpqua National Forest, Oregon, estimated to be 11,093,000 feet B.M., more or less, of sugar pine, 9,169,000 feet B.M., more or less, of Douglas-fir, 119,000 feet B.M., more or less, of ponderosa pine, and an unestimated amount of other species of sawtimber. Sealed bids accompanied by required payment received by the Regional Forester prior to 2:00 P. M., April 6, 1948, will be considered the equivalent of an oral bid and posted for the information of all bidders. The appraised value of the timber according to the long-term, normal market and operating conditions is \$9.45 per M. foot for sugar pine and Western white pine, \$2.55 per M. foot for ponderosa pine, \$3.05 per M. foot for Douglas-fir, \$1.00 per M. foot for Western hemlock and other species. No bid will be considered which is less than these rates as

a base rate applicable through the entire period of the sale agreement, plus at least \$10.30 per M. foot for sugar pine and Western white pine, \$3.15 per M. foot for ponderosa pine, \$3.55 per M. foot for Douglas-fir, and \$3.55 per M. foot for Western hemlock and other species, the total to apply for all timber cut prior to June 1, 1950. On that date and at other times, as stated in the contract, total rates will be redetermined, but in no event will the redetermined stumpage rates be less than the basic appraised value as first above stated, and in no event will rates below those to be established until at least 7,000,000 feet B.M. have been cut and paid for at not less than the bid rates. In addition to the prices bid for stumpage a cooperative deposit of \$0.40 per M. foot B.M., to be used by the Forest Service for paying the cost of slash disposal and a cooperative deposit of \$0.45 per M. foot B.M., to cover the cost of tree planting, seed sowing and timber stand improvement work on the area cut over, for the total cut of timber under the terms of the agreement, will be required. \$10,000.00, to be applied on the purchase price, refunded, or retained in part as liquidated damages, according to the conditions of sale, must accompany each sealed bid and must be shown to be in the possession of oral bidders as a qualification for auction bidding. If an oral bid is declared to be high at the closing of the auction, the bidder must immediately make the required payment and confirm the bid by submitting it in writing on a Forest Service bid form. The right to reject any and all bids is reserved. Before bids are submitted, full information concerning the timber, the conditions of sale and the submission of bids should be obtained from the Forest Supervisor, Roseburg, Oregon, or the District Ranger, Tiller, Oregon.
