

Lesnevich K. O.'s Fox in One Round

NEW YORK, March 6.—(AP)—Gus Lesnevich, 32-year-old light heavyweight boxer, last night flattened "Blackjack" Billy Fox in the first round of their second battle. It took Gus ten rounds to do the trick in their first engagement.

The sell-out crowd of 18,453 which paid \$149,519 got a big bang out of Gus' power display last night.

After a few seconds of sparring, Gus nicked Billy with a right. As the challenger scrambled out of range in confusion he slipped and fell on all fours, taking no count.

Carefully looking for his chance, Gus maneuvered Fox toward his own corner. As Billy threw a right hand, Lesnevich countered with a right to the body.

Then, he threw the book at Billy Boy. A right to the head, another and six in all. Fox sank to the canvas. He wobbled to his feet at six and Lesnevich rushed after him, tugging at referee Frank Fullam who was

trying to wipe the resin dust off Billy's gloves. When Fullam let them to at it again, the champ drove home a murderous right that draped well-beaten Billy over the bottom rope. Helpless he rolled to the floor, tried weakly to get up but couldn't make it.

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no surprise at "my contemplated arrest" and hotly attacking the Truman administration for "political intimidation."

He said 10 persons had been arrested recently and held without bail for deportation.

"This new device of arresting people on flimsy legal technicalities in order to remove them temporarily from the labor and political scene is both threatening and frightening to all believers in American justice and fair play."

"It boils down to this: play ball with Truman and support his reelection or else—my contemplated arrest following similar arrests of other labor union spokesmen is not surprising to us. We have known it was on its way for some time. Truman and

his political henchmen are desperate."

After a hearing in 1939, an examiner held Bridges was not deportable because he had not been proven to be a Communist party member at the time of the hearing. Another hearing was held in 1941 and he was ordered deported. But the U. S. Supreme Court reversed the order, holding it was not shown that Bridges had advocated force and violence to overthrow the government.

Governor Hall Seeks Election

PORTLAND, March 6.—(AP)—Gov. John H. Hall today said he would seek return to office.

Elevated to the governorship by last October's plane crash which took the lives of Gov. Earl Snell and Senate President Marshall Cornett, Hall said, "I have had no experience in a state-wide campaign and do not have the backing of any group or organization. I have no specific changes or recommendations to suggest, nor do I propose to make empty promises impossible of fulfillment. As issues arise, they will be met squarely and discussed frankly."

Hall became governor through his office as speaker of the House of Representatives—the constitution placing that office after the Senate presidency in the succession order. He was Republican representative from Multnomah County.

He will be opposed for the Republican nomination in the May 21 primary by Douglas McKay, state senator from Salem; Glenn Ackerman, Portland real estate man, and possibly by others as filings do not close until Friday.

Low Wallace, Democratic national committeeman, has announced that he will seek his party's nomination.

The Harvard scientist labeled the committee's current probe of Dr. Edward U. Condon, head of the National Bureau of Standards, as "a national disgrace and a national danger."

WASHINGTON, March 6.—(AP)—The House Un-American Activities Committee lined up more witnesses today to support its charge that Dr. Edward U. Condon is "one of the weakest links in our atomic security."

Committee members said the group plans to summon four persons to testify at hearings on a subcommittee's report that the government scientist associated "knowingly or unknowingly" with alleged Russian spies.

The witnesses being subpoenaed were not named.

The blast at the director of the government's Bureau of Standards was loosed earlier this week. Condon, who has worked on a number of this country's secret wartime weapons, promptly denied it.
